

Thank you for inquiring regarding international travel with your pet. Information regarding pet travel and individual country requirements can be accessed at: <https://www.aphis.usda.gov/aphis/pet-travel>.

International pet travel often involves very specific vaccines or tests which may in some cases be accompanied by a waiting period or must be completed in a very specific order. Please plan accordingly and allow sufficient time for travel planning. Completing an international health certificate and its associated services may require multiple visits.

Due to the amount of time involved in researching international pet travel health requirements and timing their requirements, we strongly recommend working with a pet travel company to facilitate the process. We recommend: Jet-A-Pet, located in Westport, CT <https://jetapetinternational.com/>

Should you choose not to work with a travel company, we require a nonrefundable \$50 deposit to research the requirements for your pet's travel. This deposit does not apply to current clients of Companion Animal Hospital that are up to date on their pets' well care. The deposit is then applied to the cost of your pet's health certificate should we complete one.

Please ensure you have completed the Health Certificate Questionnaire in its entirety to facilitate this process. Include any vaccine certificates or previous medical records and provide current contact information for any vets that have performed recent vaccinations or treatments. If records of required vaccines or testing are not available, they may need to be repeated.
